### Important Dates:

- **Call for Art Submission Dates:** April 15, 12:00a - June 15, 11:59p
- **Notification:** All artists will receive email notification by July 3rd
- **Juror Awards Artwork Drop-Off:** July 10 (10am -2pm) at Copley Town Hall
- **Accepted Artwork Drop-Off:** July 31, (10am -2pm) at Brighten Brewing Company
- **Exhibition Opening & Artists Reception:** Thursday, August 3, 6pm - 8pm at Brighten Brewing Company
- **Artwork Pick-Up:** September 11, (10am -2pm) at Brighten Brewing Company

**How to Enter:** All Submissions will be done online. Please read our full Submission Guidelines in the Prospectus before submitting.

**Eligibility:** Open to artists of all levels who currently live in Copley; work in or maintain a business in Copley; are past CHS graduates; are current or incoming students in 9th-12th grade attending Copley High School, an out-of-district school, or homeschool.

**Acceptable Media:** painting, drawing, printmaking, mixed media, photography, textiles, all traditional mediums on any support - canvas, board, paper, wood, panel, aluminum, etc., and 3-dimensional work that can be wired and hung on a wall.

**Theme:** "COMMUNITY"

What comes to mind when you think of community? Your artwork should reflect your personal interpretation of community - whether that means capturing the essence of a particular location, celebrating the connections between people and places, or exploring the intersections of identity and belonging.

**Submission Fees:** Each artist has the option of paying a Submission Fee or doing Community Service in place of the submission fee to enter up to three pieces of art.

- Adult - \$25.00 OR 3 hours of Community Service
- Students - \$10.00 OR 2 hours of Community Service  
Student refers to anyone who is currently in high school or will be starting high school as a freshman in the upcoming academic year, as well as those who are graduating from high school in the current academic year.

### Size limits and preparing artwork:

- Artwork, may not exceed 36" wide and 60" high" (including frame), or 8" deep and cannot exceed 20lbs
- All artwork MUST have a wire and be ready to hang on the wall; two-dimensional work must be framed or have a finished edge

**What you need to know:**

- Work submitted must be the artist's original artwork. No reproductions, giclee, or AI art will be accepted
- An artist statement (up to 300 words) is required with submission
- Artwork MUST be wired and ready for display if selected for exhibition
- The artist agrees to leave their work up through the end of the exhibition
- Artists MUST be available for pick-up and drop-off dates to sign in and sign out their work
- Artwork that contains offensive language, or overtly sexual content or imagery, will not be considered
